COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Resource class is designed to supplement the general education classroom instruction of students with disabilities for those who need it, in addition to providing support for other disability related needs. This supplemental support is directly related to the student's IEP and include, but are not limited to, the following areas:

*social skills	*transition planning	*organizational skills	*study skills

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- *The teacher will provide extra time for students to complete assessments.*
- *The teacher will receive/review, reinforce, and re-teach content area concepts.*
- *The student will utilize testing accommodations & program modifications.*
- *The student will utilize powerschool to check course grades and to check for missing assignments.*
- *The student will develop skills necessary to achieve goals on Individualized Education Plans.*
- *The student will develop organizational skills, study skills, social/emotional skills.*
- *The student will develop study and test taking skills to improve performance.*
- *The student will develop an appropriate transition plan (plan for after high school).*

MATERIALS:

- Missing and/or incomplete work from core area classes
- Pen or Pencil
- Chromebook

GRADING:

- 2 Grades per week (Mastery of Content 60%, Measure of Progress 40%)

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

4. Complete assigned tasks.
